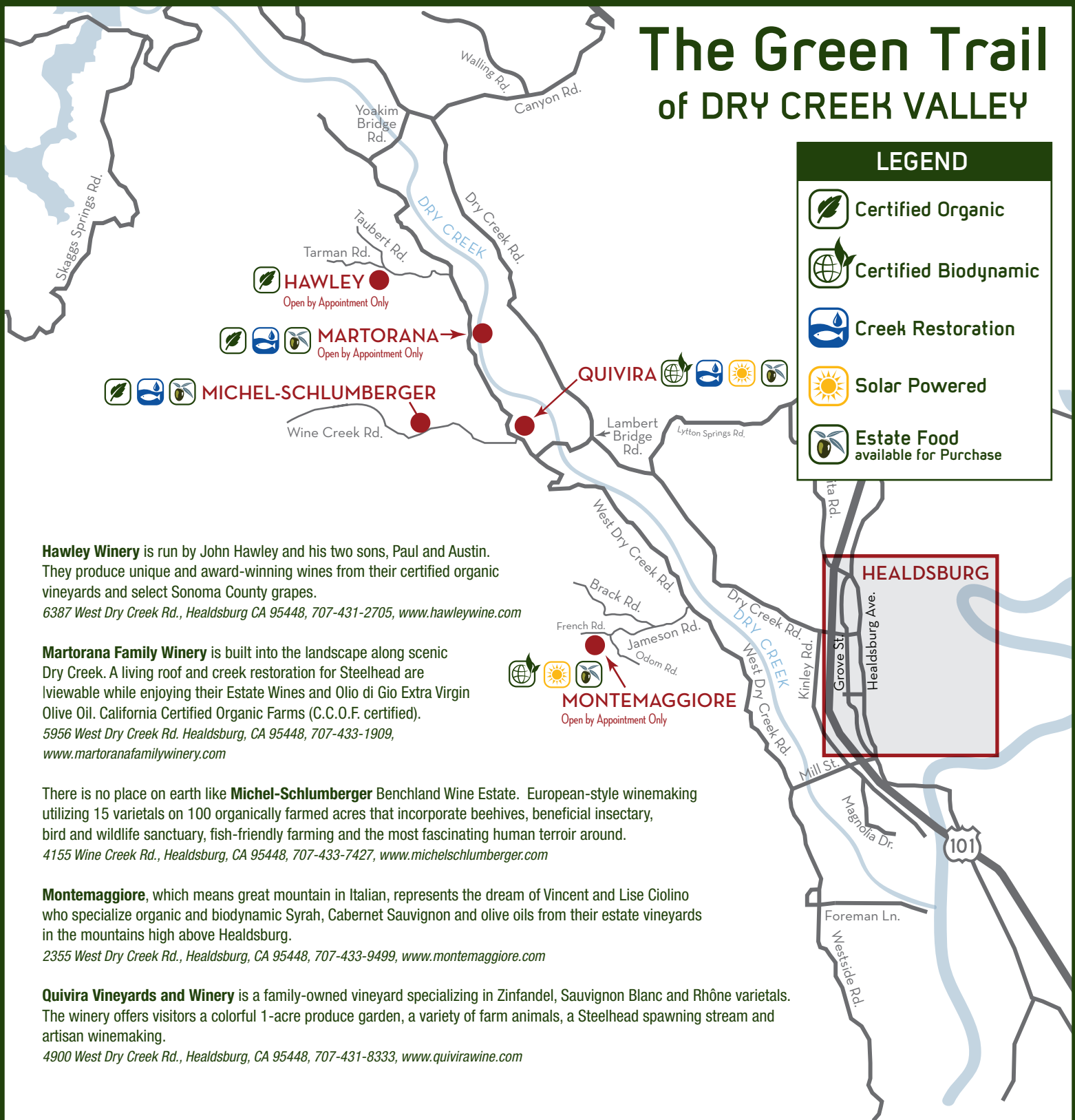


The Green Trail of DRY CREEK VALLEY
